FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Does the hearing officer have jurisdiction over the expedited hearing request?
- 2. Is the Student eligible for special education and related services under the IDEA?
- 3. If the Student is eligible under the IDEA, is an outplacement at Ben Bronz Academy appropriate for the 2018-2019 school year?
- 4. Are the Parents entitled to reimbursement for tuition, transportation and related expenses for Ben Bronz Academy for the 2018-2019 school year?
- 5. Did the Board violate Child Find in the 2017-2018 school year?
- 6. Did the Board violate Child Find in the 2018-2019 school year?
- 7. What is the Student's Stay Put placement?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Student/ Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on September 4, 2018. The Hearing Officer was appointed on September 4, 2018. A Prehearing Conference was held on September 7, 2018. On September 18, 2018, via email, the Complaint was withdrawn without prejudice.
