## **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

## PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The parents filed a due process complaint on February 4, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on February 6, 2019. A prehearing conference was set for February 15<sup>th</sup>, where the issues were set forth and a hearing date was set for early April. The parties requested an extension of the mailing date at the end of March, which was granted, and a new hearing date was set for early May. On April 25<sup>th</sup>, the attorney for the parents contacted the Hearing Officer via email to withdraw the Parent's request for due process

#### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Was the Student denied FAPE by the West Hartford Board of Education (Board) for the 2017-2018 and 2018-2019 school years, including ESY for 2018 and 2019?
- 2. If the Student was denied FAPE, is placement at the Quaker Lane School appropriate for the Student for the 2018-2019 school year and is the Board responsible for the costs associated with this placement?
- 3. Is the Student entitled compensatory education and/or to any other relief as deemed appropriate by the Hearing Officer?

### **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:**

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
