FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Whether the District failed to meet its obligations under Child Find?
- 2. Whether the District failed to provide the Student with FAPE during the 2016-2017 school year, and extended school year period?
- 3. Whether the District failed to provide the Student with FAPE during the 2017-2018 school year, and extended school year period?
- 4. Whether the District failed to provide the Student with FAPE during the 2018-2019 school year, and extended school year period?
- 5. Whether the District violated the Student's rights under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent(s) filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on April 18, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on April 22, 2019. A Prehearing Conference was noticed for and held on April 30, 2019. On August 21, 2019, via email, the Complaint was withdrawn by the Parents without prejudice.
