#### **ISSUES:**

- 1. Did the Board offer an appropriate program for the 2018-19 school year?
- 2. If not, is placement at Cedarhurst School the appropriate program for the Student for the 2018-19 school year and should the Board be ordered to place the Student at Cedarhurst School for the 2018-19 school year?
- 3. Is the Student entitled to compensatory education?
