ISSUES:

- 1. Did the Board offer the Student appropriate programs in the least restrictive environment for the 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 school years and extended school years?
- 2. Does the Student require a residential placement?
- 3. If so, shall the Hearing Officer require the Board to reimburse Parents for Student's unilateral placement.
- 4. Do the circumstances warrant an award of compensatory education?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on April 2, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on April 4, 2019 and conducted a Prehearing Conference on April 26, 2019. The hearing was scheduled for April 23, 2019. The Parents withdrew their Hearing Request on May 16, 2019 without prejudice.
