FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The parents filed a due process complaint on May 13, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on May 14, 2019. A prehearing conference was set for May 20, 2019, where the issues were set forth and a hearing date was set for July. The parties indicated several times that a settlement was being reached, and also indicated on several occasions that the achieved settlement was being executed. On October 11th, the attorney for the parents contacted the Hearing Officer via email to withdraw the parent's request for due process.

ISSUES:

- 1. Is the Student being provided with FAPE in the LRE for the 2019-2020 school year?
- 2. If not, is placement at the Forman School in appropriate for the Student for the 2019-2020 school year?
- 3. Is the Student entitled compensatory education and/or to any other relief as deemed appropriate by the Hearing Officer?

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
