FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Was the Central Auditory Processing evaluation provided by the District appropriate?
- 2. Did the District commit violations, which resulted in the denial of FAPE to the Student?
- 3. If the District committed violations, what remedies should be ordered?

SUMMARY AND PROCEDURAL HISTORY:

Case 19-0483 was commenced by the District by request filed on April 11, 2019. A prehearing conference was held on April 29, 2019. At the prehearing conference, hearing dates were set for June 18, 2019 and June 20, 2019 and the decision date was determined to be May 24, 2019. The hearings were subsequently cancelled and the decision date extended to October 7, 2019.

Case 19-0610 was commenced by the Parents by request received on June 24, 2019. The case was consolidated with Case 19-0483 by order of Hearing Officer Ann F. Bird on July 5, 2019.

On October 2, 2019, the undersigned hearing officer was advised by both attorneys that the parties had reached a settlement in the case and that both matters should therefore be dismissed.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matters are dismissed.
