- 1. Did the Board offer and/or provide an appropriate program for the 2017-2018, 2018-19 school years, including ESY?
- 2. If not, is the Grove School the appropriate program and should the Student be placed there at the expense of the Board?
- 3. Is the Student entitled to compensatory education?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parents filed the Due Process Hearing Complaint on August 5, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on August 5, 2019. The pre-hearing conference was held on August 20, 2019. Hearings were scheduled for October 22, 2019, October 24, 2019, and October 31, 2019.
