FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- 1. Did the Board commit procedural violations by failing to timely evaluate the Student?
- 2. If so, are Parents entitled to reimbursement for tuition, transportation and education related costs at Windward School for the 2018-2019 school year as a result of the Board's violations?
- 3. Did the IEP propose by the Board deny the Student FAPE?
- 4. If so, are Parents entitled to reimbursement for tuition, transportation and education related costs at Windward School for the 2018-2019 and 2019-2020 school years?

PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Parent filed the Due Process Complaint and Request for Hearing on August 22, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on the same day and conducted a Prehearing Conference on September 25, 2019. The Hearing Officer granted the Parent's request for extension of the mailing date to December 4, 2019 so the parties could engage in mediation. The hearing was scheduled for November 22, 2019. On November 19, 2019 the Parent's attorney withdrew the Due Process Complaint with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The matter is **DISMISSED** with prejudice.
