## **FINAL DECISION AND ORDER**

### **ISSUES**:

1. Did the Board provide FAPE during the 2018-2019 school year?

- 2. Did the 2019-2020 IEP provide FAPE?
- 3. If not, is the full day preschool program at Whiting Lane the appropriate placement?
- 4. Did the Board violate the procedural rights of the Parents by failing to convene a PPT when requested by the Parents on August 12, 2019?
- 5. Is the Student entitled to compensatory education as a remedy?
- 6. If so, for what period of time?

#### PROCEDURAL HISTORY/SUMMARY:

The Due Process Complaint was filed on October 10, 2019. The Hearing Officer was appointed on October 10, 2019. A Prehearing Conference was noticed for and held on October 18, 2019. On December 12, 2019, via email, the Parents withdrew their due process complaint with prejudice.

In light of the above, the matter is **DISMISSED**.
