FINAL DECISION AND ORDER

ISSUES:

- a. Out-of-school placement for Student as well as lack of previous detailed plans that the school failed to prove that plans were implemented to assist Student.
- b. Whether the District is failing to provide the Student with agreed-upon services?
- c. Whether an one-on-one paraprofessional should be provided to Student in order to assist the Special Education staff in planning strategies to assist Student?

PROCEDURAL BACKGROUND:

The Parent, on behalf of the Student, filed this Request for a Due Process Hearing on October 28, 2019. The Hearing Officer was assigned on October 28, 2019. A Prehearing Conference was scheduled but postponed by request of counsel. Prior to rescheduling the conference, on November 5, 2019, counsel for the Board filed a Sufficiency Challenge. Additionally, thereafter, but also on November 5, 2019, the parent, on behalf of the student, reported that the matter was settled and withdrew the request for due process with prejudice. Accordingly, the matter is dismissed with prejudice.

FINAL DECISION AND ORDER:

The case is DISMISSED with prejudice.
