

HOW TO USE THIS BALLOT

CAUTION: This ballot may consist of more than one sheet.

I. TO MARK THIS BALLOT.

Make a clear, bold mark in each appropriate oval as shown.

Use a black or blue pen or pencil.

Vote for candidates individually. Do not mark the party names in any way.

II. TO VOTE FOR CANDIDATES. In most cases, only one mark or write-in vote is allowable in each column (that is, for each office).

A. TO VOTE FOR CANDIDATES ON THE BALLOT.

Mark the oval left of the name of each candidate for whom you wish to vote.
