DEPUTY SECRETARY OF THE STATE TO RANDOMLY SELECT VOTING PRECINCTS TO HAVE PRIMARY RESULTS AUDITED

Deputy Secretary of the State James Spallone will randomly select voting precincts to have results audited following the recent August 9 primary. Five percent of the polling precincts that use optical scan machines are subject to the audit, as prescribed by Connecticut General Statutes 9-320f. Those hand counted ballots will be matched against vote totals from optical scan machines.
